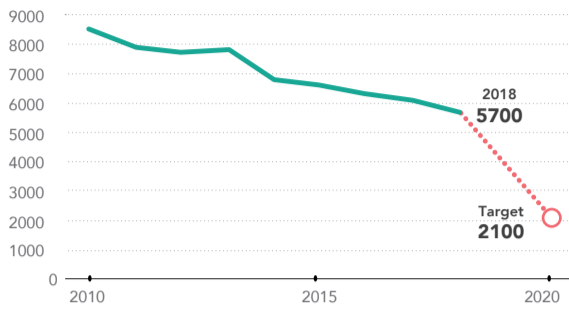
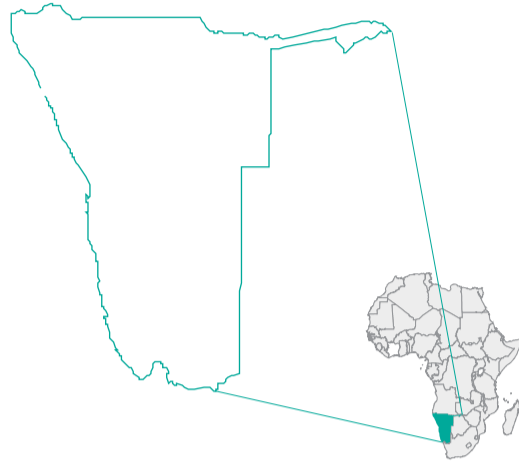

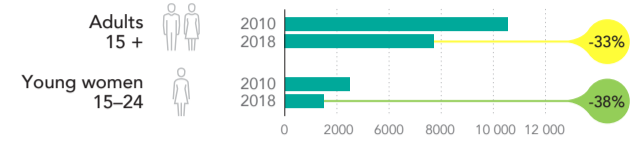
## New HIV infections among adults aged 15+



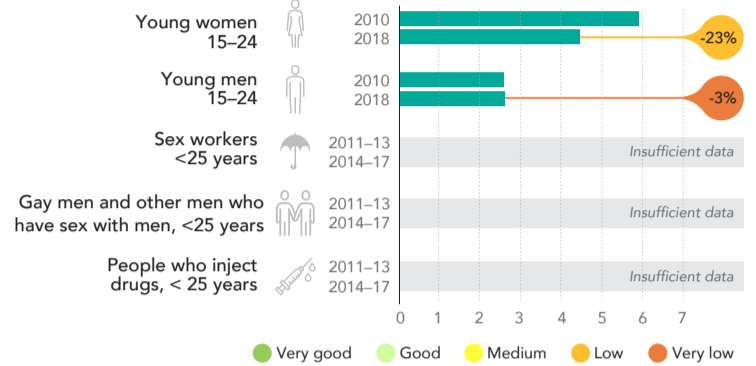
New HIV infections are declining too slowly to achieve the 2020 targets. Programme scale-up is needed.

### ADOLESCENT GIRLS, YOUNG WOMEN & MALE PARTNERS

Condom use with a non-regular partner among young people (%)

### VOLUNTARY MEDICAL MALE CIRCUMCISION

Uptake of voluntary medical male circumcision

23 (by 2020 target achieved), 22 (Male circumcision prevalence 15-24)

Target: 90%

### PRE-EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS

5600 Number of people who used oral Pre-exposure prophylaxis at least once during the past 12 months

Target: 73%

### ANTIRETROVIRAL TREATMENT

87 People Living with HIV virally suppressed

Target: 73%

Country messages:

- 4** (Very low): Condom use, completion of lower secondary education, coverage of dedicated programmes
- 6** (Low): Condom use, education level, coverage of prevention interventions (at least 2 in past 3 months)
- 8** (Medium): Condom use, condom distribution
- 10** (Good): Regulatory approval, Pre-exposure guidelines, Pre-exposure targets, Pre-exposure coverage per 100 new HIV infections

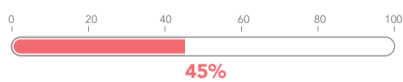
### AVOIDED HEALTH CARE DUE TO STIGMA & DISCRIMINATION (%)



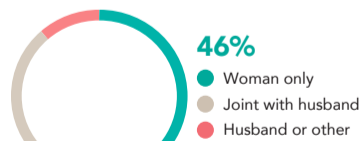
### WOMEN EXPERIENCED INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE (%)



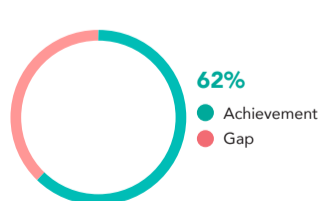
### SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND RIGHTS STRATEGY: LEVEL OF HIV LINKAGES (%)
