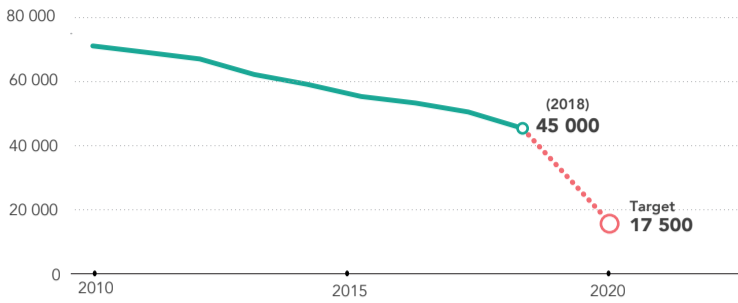
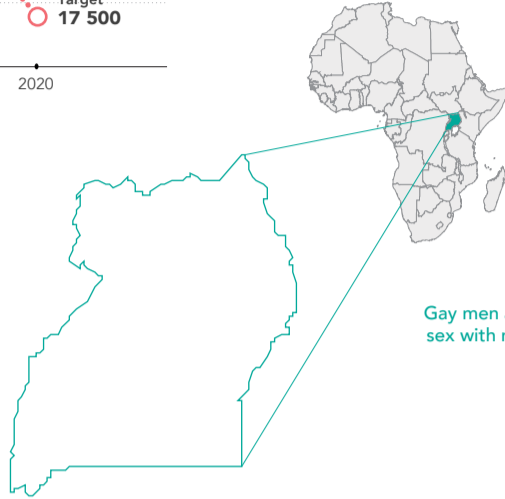


New HIV infections among adults aged 15+

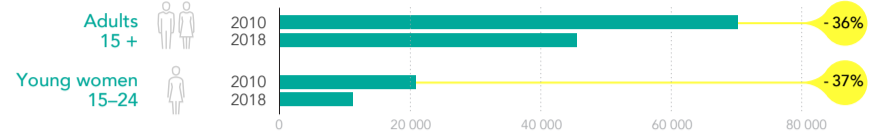


New HIV infections among adults aged 15 years and older declined by **36%** between 2010 and 2018, which is too slow to achieve the 2020 targets. Programme scale-up is needed.

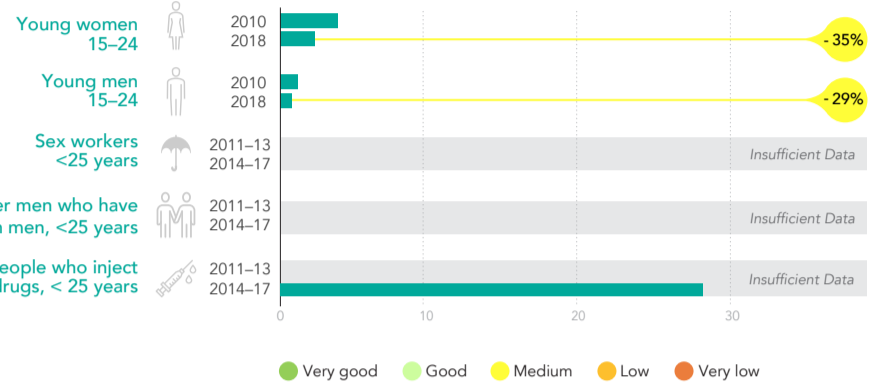

ADOLESCENT GIRLS, YOUNG WOMEN & MALE PARTNERS

Condom use with a non-regular partner among young people (%)

Young women: 44% (Target: 90%)
Young men: 63% (Target: 90%)

32% of priority locations that have adolescent girls, young women programs

Country messages: There is slow progress towards the 2020 targets. Address stock-out issues, increase demand creation and improve data management.

Score: 3

SEX WORKERS

Condom use at last paid sex (%)

Sex workers: 69% (Target: 95%)
Clients: 73% (Target: 95%)

Received two interventions in past 3 months: Insufficient Data

Country messages: Condom use among sex workers and clients remains too low. Condom promotion and consistent community outreach activities for sex workers need to be scaled up.

GAY MEN & OTHER MEN WHO HAVE SEX WITH MEN

Condom use at last anal sex (%)

Gay men and other men who have sex with men: 39% (Target: 90%)

Received two interventions in past 3 months: Insufficient Data

Country messages: Slow progress has been made. Invest in demand generation and condom education, and implement a condom total market approach to address inequities.

Score: Insufficient Data

PEOPLE WHO INJECT DRUGS

Condom use with a non-regular partner

With safe injections: Insufficient Data (Target: 95%)
On OST: Insufficient Data (Target: 40%)

Received two interventions in past 3 months: 8%

Country messages: Programming recently started with the establishment of a national treatment site and the development of service delivery guidelines.

Score: 1

CONDOMS

Condom use with a non-regular partner

Women 15-49: 38% (Target: 90%)
Men 15-49: 62% (Target: 90%)

Condom distribution need met: 93%

Country messages: Progress is too slow to achieve the 2020 targets. Address intermittent stock-outs, increase demand creation and improve data management.

Score: 7

VOLUNTARY MEDICAL MALE CIRCUMCISION

Uptake of voluntary medical male circumcision

% of 2020 target achieved: 40% (Target: 90%)
Male circumcision prevalence 15-24: 49% (Target: 90%)

Annual voluntary medical male Circumcision target achieved: 77%

Country messages: National targets need to be set that are aligned with global targets. Training for voluntary medical male circumcision teams and accreditation of health facilities must be scaled up.

Score: 7

PRE-EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS

Number of people who used oral pre-exposure prophylaxis at least once during the past 12 months: 10,779

Composite pre-exposure prophylaxis preparedness score (0-10): 10

Country messages: Good progress has been made, but this should be sustained and accelerated.

Score: 10

ANTIRETROVIRAL TREATMENT

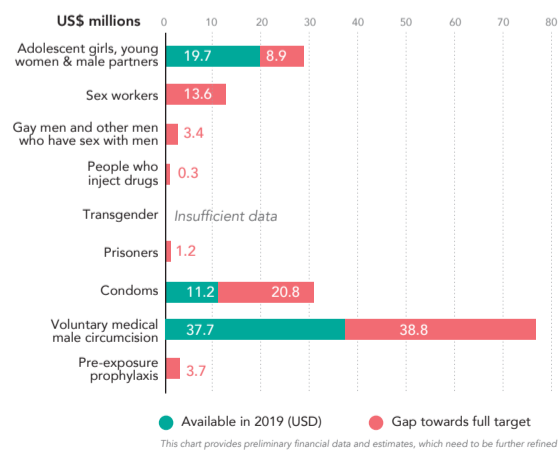
People Living with HIV virally suppressed: 61% (Target: 73%)

Country messages: Good progress has been made, but this should be sustained and accelerated.

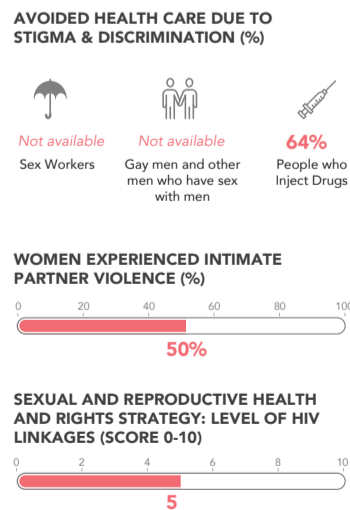

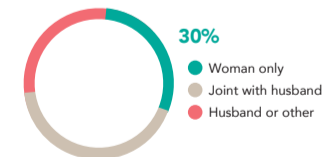
Estimated HIV prevention financing and gaps



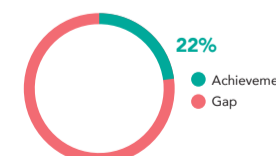
